



Primary Care Chronic Enhancement Program

The VMC Care Management Committee has reviewed the results of the two-year Chronic Care Enhancement (PCP CCE) Pilot and in April 2011 the decision was made and approved by VMC's Board of Directors to move from pilot status to a program effective October 1, 2011.

The goal of this program is to identify VMC members assigned to Primary Care Providers who are enrolled in MVP, TVHP and Fletcher Allen Preferred Medical Plans, who may be at high risk for medical compromise and/or high cost and provide supplemental resources in support of their care.

Criteria to participate include:

- Provider is a Primary Care Physician
- Complete an initial care plan for each enrolled member
- Attestation at 6 month intervals for re-enrollment
- Requires annual comprehensive preventive exam and at least one other E&M visit in a 12 months period by the PCP for payment.
